A wage increase will be effective November 30, 2020 through November 30, 2021. The following wages rate and fringe benefits will increase, Inside Wage rate \$32.00, Local Pension \$1.88, Annuity \$3.60, and Health Fund \$5.92/HR, and 3% for NEBF. When \$0.43 cents for the apprenticeship contribution is included, the total package for a Journeyman Wireman will be \$44.79.

Finally, please allow me to express my sincere gratitude and thanks to all of you for your strong vote of confidence in our administration, which was shown in the results of the September 12th election. The IBEW and Local 130 is important to me, I love and respect this great organization and all its members. I greatly appreciate all it has done and continues to do for my family, members, and myself.
