Dear Brothers and Sisters,

In this newsletter you will find information on the recent AFL-CIO Labor Day Picnic, general election, upcoming discussion and vote at the next Union Meeting, and dues increase. The IBEW Local 130 membership picnic, social media posts, service pin night, and lastly, you will find information regarding the retirement of our Apprenticeship Director, Sandy Theriot and her replacement David Crumb.

The AFL-CIO Labor Day picnic was a huge success with great food and union fellowship. There were just over 1,000 in attendance and the funds raised will go to Dads Against Diabetes. Many political candidates and city councilmembers, also in attendance was Governor John Bel Edwards who had offered remarks.

Early voting for **General Election** will begin October 25<sup>th</sup> through November 1<sup>st</sup>. We encourage everyone to support the roster of Labor endorsed candidates to vote on **November 8<sup>th</sup>**, they are the ones who support us. The endorsed candidate list is enclosed and will remain posted on our daily email blast through election day. This upcoming election will again determine the future of our country and the stakes are too high for working Americans to sit out. Louisiana has been controlled by the Republican Legislature for the past 15 years and we are still last in every category compared to the other 49 states. As organized labor, our vote can make the difference!

The Inflation Reduction Act that was passed in congress on Sunday, August 7<sup>th</sup>, 2022 and is a scaled-down version of President Biden's," Build Back Better Bill." All 50 democratic senators voted for the bill and all 50 republicans voted against it, requiring Vice President Kamala Harris as per the constitution to cast the tiebreaking vote allowing passage 51 to 50. The bill provides funding to combat climate change, imposes new taxes on corporations that paid no taxes. It will lower drug prices for families and fund the continued healthcare coverage for people that had no coverage.

Please make every effort to attend the next **Union Meeting** which will be held on **Thursday, October 13<sup>,</sup> 2022, at 6:00 p.m.** in the **Alexander Room, 3<sup>rd</sup> Fl., 3200 Ridgelake Drive.**, and be prompt as we will need the participation of the membership to **discuss and vote on allocating the \$1.20 pay increase**. The increase will go into effect on December 5<sup>th</sup>. New members will be obligated at the union meeting. I look forward to seeing you at the Union Meeting.

Per the IBEW, "effective January 1, 2023, there will be an increase of two dollars (\$2.00) for the per capita that is paid to the general fund." There will also be an increase of two dollars (\$2.00) in the IBEW Pension Benefit Fund (PBF) contribution, which applies to "A" members only. The following rates will apply to the international office portion of all monthly dues for January 2023, and thereafter:

Members who pay their dues in advance must be charged the appropriate rate. If you've signed up for autopay or your dues is being drafted through our credit union, rates will be updated. If you are signed through bill pay with your bank, you are required to contact your bank to apply the change.

The IBEW Local 130 Membership Picnic will be held on Saturday, October 15<sup>th</sup> at 11:00 a.m. to 3:00 p.m., in City Park, Shelter #1. This picnic is free to our membership, so please bring your family for fun activities, food, and drinks.

Local 130 will hold its **Annual Service Pin Ceremony** on **Tuesday, December 13, at 6:00 P.M. in the Alexander Room** to honor the service of our brother and sister members to our beloved Local. Enclosed is a list of members who will be receiving pins this year. Members and their families are invited to attend.

Our work picture continues to improve. At this time, we have full-employment and several large projects that will be hiring this year or by early of next year such as the new Harrah's hotel tower and Charity hospital that was awarded to Frischhertz Electric. We are waiting for the following projects to be awarded, Sewage and Waterboard, and the development of the Ernest Morial Convention Centers master plan. Organizing is top priority as we will need more manpower in the future. Our organizers, Corky Cortez and Rodney Wallis have been able to organize some men and put them right to work.
